

Child Welfare Committees (CWC) :

The Juvenile justice (care and protection of Children) Act, 2000 makes it mandatory to establish one child welfare committee in each district as the final authority to dispose of cases for the care, protection, treatment, development and rehabilitation of children in need of care & protection and to provide for their basic needs and protection of human rights.

Location of CWC

As provided under the JJ Act, 2000, the child welfare committee should hold its sittings in the premises of children's Home. According CWC meeting is held on every Thursday in Boy's home and once in a month CWC meeting is held in girls home. Children aged between 6 and 18 years who need care and protection are deal here i.e., Orphan, children of distressed family, single parent, rejected children, Neglected children, child abused by parents, run-away, child labours etc.. CWC rehabilitates such children by bringing them to main stream. providing proper care & protection either their parents/ institution / guardian. CWC also declared child free for adoption legally.

CWC consists of 5 members of these selected 5 members. **Shri Sudheersingh Ghorpade** is the President, **Shri G.C Reshmi, Basavaraj N Samshi, Girishgouda S Patil, Kariyamma M Shelavadi** are members.
